Sunday School This week's lesson is about the baptism of Jesus from Luke chapter 3. The people were in great anticipation. There had been no prophet in Israel for four hundred years. Jesus had come to take on the sin of the world. By entering the waters set apart for sinners, Christ made Himself to stand as one of them. This alignment with sinners in His Baptism was the beginning of the road to the end. Here, He is baptized with the Holy Spirit in the Jordan. At the cross, He would undergo the destroying fire of God's wrath for sin. Now all the benefits of Christ's death and resurrection are sealed to you in Baptism. You receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. In Baptism, Christ takes you through the fire with Him. All four Gospels describe the Baptism of Jesus. Luke is unique in putting it in the past tense. Why? His focus is not just on the person of John or on the act of Baptism. His focus is on the other two persons of the Holy Trinity, who attest to the messianic identity of Jesus. Who can doubt the doctrine of the Trinity when we have such a clear passage in which all three persons are present vet functioning in distinct ways? To each person who is baptized into Christ, God says, "You are My beloved child".
