




## Invocation (based on Psalms 48:1,14,8a,9-10)

- P: Yahweh is great and certainly worthy of praise.
- C: For God, our God, is our defender forever.
- P: We heard about God's mighty deeds, and within His presence:
- C: we reflect on your loyal love, O God.
- P: The praise You receive as far away as the ends of the earth is worthy of your reputation, O God.
- C: For God, our God, is our defender forever.
- P: Selah...let now us pause in His presence....

"Yahweh" is the personal Name of God the Father in Hebrew, often translated simply as "LORD".

## Confession of Sins (based on Psalm 42:1-2,5,8,11)

- P: As a deer longs for streams of water,
- C: so I long for you, O God! I thirst for God, for the living God. When will I be able to go and appear in God's presence?
- P: Why are you discouraged in your soul? Why are you upset? Wait for God!
- C: But I know my sinfulness. I feel as if I am separated from God's presence.
- P: Why are you discouraged in your soul? Why are you upset? Wait for God!
- C: But I am overwhelmed by my sinfulness. When will I be able to go and appear in God's presence?
- P: By day the LORD decrees His loyal love, through the Gospel of His Son, Jesus Christ, and by night He gives you a song, a prayer to the God of your life.
- C: Through the cross and resurrection, I will again give thanks to my God for His saving intervention. Father, reveal Your light and Your faithfulness. They will lead me; they will escort me back to Your holy presence. Then I will go to the altar of God, who gives me great joy.
- P: Wait for God and His salvation.
- C: Then I will again give thanks to my God for His saving intervention.
- P: Selah...We pause in His presence,
- C: remembering our sins and our need for the Lord's forgiveness.

## (silent meditation)

## Absolution (Declaration of Forgiveness) (based on Psalm 49:7,9,15)

P: Certainly no one can redeem another person from their sin;

no one can pay God an adequate ransom price

so that they might continue to live forever and not experience death.

But God Himself will rescue your life from the power of the grave;

Jesus Christ took on flesh, paid the price with His own life,

so that you will continue to live forever even after death.

Certainly He will pull you to safety, rescuing you from your sin.

- Therefore, in the stead and by the command of my Lord Jesus Christ, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
- C: Amen.



## Psalm 82 (Passion Translation)

#### This Week's Psalm Reading

<sup>1</sup>All rise! For God now comes to judge as he convenes heaven's courtroom. He judges every judge and rules over every ruler, saying, <sup>2</sup> "How long will you judges refuse to listen to the voice of true justice and continue to corrupt what is right by judging in favor of the wrong?" Selah. Pause in his presence. <sup>3</sup> "Defend the defenseless, the fatherless and the forgotten, the disenfranchised and the destitute. <sup>4</sup> Your duty is to deliver the poor and the powerless; liberate them from the grasp of the wicked. <sup>5</sup> But you continue in your darkness and ignorance while the foundations of society are shaken to the core! <sup>6</sup> Didn't I commission you as judges, saying, 'You are all like gods, since you judge on my behalf. You are all like sons of the Most High, my representatives.' <sup>7</sup> Nevertheless, in death you are nothing but mere men! You will be laid in the ground like any prince and you will die."

<sup>8</sup> All rise! For God now takes his place as judge of all the earth. Don't you know that everything and everyone belongs to him?

The nations will be sifted in his hands!

## 1 Thessalonians 5:14-24 (ESV)



## Preparation for the Lord's Supper

All Christians who are baptized and have been instructed

are invited to receive Communion with us

if you believe as we do—that the bread is the body of Christ, and the wine is the blood of Christ,


truly present for us for the forgiveness of our sins.

If this is a new teaching to you, or if this is different than you believe,

we ask that you wait to commune until we've had a further chance to talk. We invite those who are not communing to come to the rail, cross your arms, and receive a blessing from the Lord.

## **Communion Distribution**

- Pastor distributes the bread, and the Elders distribute the wine—with individual cups or common cup. The individual trays also contain alcohol-removed wine in the center of each tray in the purple cups.
- Each side will be ushered from the center aisle to the communion rail, row by row, starting with the front.
- Go to the rail on your side of the sanctuary, filling in starting with the outside wall towards the center.
- Once you have received the elements, you may remain at the rail for prayer and leave at your own pace.
- Return to your seat using the outside aisle.
- Use the distribution time to prepare yourself for communion, sing the hymns as prayers to God, and maintain this as meditative time.

P: Lord, remember us in Your kingdom, and teach us to pray:





P: The peace of the Lord be with you always. C: And also with you.(We greet one another in peace saying "God's peace" or "The Lord be with you.")




