


Featured Books:

"This Bible is the first in English to be developed from the ground-up with notes that are distinctively Lutheran, prepared by Lutheran theologians and pastors from more than twenty Lutheran church bodies. Current Lutheran scholarship, insights from the Church Fathers, and rich devotional



commentary provides meaningful perspective for both young and mature Christians" (from Concordia Publishing House). This Bible uses the English Standard Version (ESV) translation, which is what Bethel generally uses in worship and Bible Study. A study Bible combines the biblical text with helpful study notes and other resources to help you quickly go deeper or get background on a passage. This version is the Compact one given out at the 2016 National Youth Gathering. Other formats of this Bible are available online at www.cph.org.

Pastor Squires uses this wonderfully biblical and insightful book for pre-marriage and marriage counseling. Written by Tim Keller, pastor of Redeemer Presbyterian in NYC, the book focuses on God's design of marriage and how that does and doesn't line up very well with how our society views marriage today. Keller is a pastor —



so this book sounds like a set of sermons with great illustrations and many ways of saying the same thing so that the repetition helps us take it to heart. This book upholds Bethel's values of aiming towards biblical marriage between one man and one woman, waiting until marriage to have sex, and avoiding divorce. However, the book – like Bethel – recognizes that we come to marriage with messy lives. And we also come to Jesus with our broken lives. So this book emphasizes meeting people where they are, looking for God's love to fuel marriage with grace, forgiveness, and leading by the Holy Spirit. If you are reading this on your own, ask Pastor for his accompanying discussion guide.
