March 1 Ten Commandments

God is our Father, Creator, Sustainer, and Guide. Like the designer of a machine knows how to make it work correctly, our Designer knows how life will work best for us.

March 8 Apostles' Creed

The term creed comes from the Latin word credo, 'I believe.' The Apostles' Creed was not written by the Apostles (the 12 Disciples) but does teach the Christian faith as they taught it.

March 15 Lord's Prayer

God tenderly invites us to believe that He is our true Father and that we are His true children, so that with all boldness and confidence we may pray to Him.

March 22 Baptism

Baptism works forgiveness of sins, rescues from death and the devil, and gives eternal salvation to all who believe this, as the words and promises of God declare.

March 29 Confession/Absolution

If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. But if we confess our sins, God, who is faithful and just, will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

April 5 Lord's Supper

In the Lord's Supper, we have been invited into the banquet of the Lord before His holy altar, forgiven by His hand, and see Him bringing us salvation in His body and blood.
