

Digital Spring Cleaning

- * Dust and sweep Remove dust and dirt from screens, air vents, and ports. (Make sure that you use the right cleaner or tool; an aggressive approach could do damage.)
- * *Cut the clutter* Delete old data and uninstall programs and apps you don't use.
- * *Organize* Arrange data and programs so that you can quickly find what you need.
- * Check your backups Ensure that your data is getting backed up regularly and that your device can be restored should anything go wrong.
- * Verify security and maintenance processes Make sure that security and maintenance services are updated and running as expected.
