Staff Position Title: Equipping Coordinator

Purpose

To coach, train, equip, and encourage people in missional living and for multiplying the ministry and leadership of the gathering of believers at Bethel. Biblically speaking: “To equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ” (Ephesians 4:12).

Desired Outcomes

- The people of Bethel will be encouraged and empowered to frame their daily living as being part of God’s Gospel mission;
- Leaders of ministry areas are equipped to lead and develop their area;
- Leaders will be trained and empowered to invite others into serving, utilizing connections and information from the Equipping Coordinator in order to do their own recruitment of servants;
- Teams and individuals will receive further training and ongoing support;
- Stories of God at work will be shared with the congregation, highlighting how He is using individuals—not just how He is using the church staff.
